## Fibredec

As part of Sustrans' continued development and expansion of cycleways throughout the country, Fibredec was specified as the chosen surfacing at Wisemans Bridge in the coastal village of Stepside, near Tenby in Pembrokeshire. The scheme through woodlands connected the existing coastal footpath and cycleway leading to the nearby resort of Tenby.

### Application Details

Sustrans prepared the site and laid Type 1 as a base for the double application of Fibredec. The incorporation of glass fibres in Fibredec provided sufficient strength for the process to be laid directly on top of Type 1, significantly reducing the total cost of the project.

Fibredec's bespoke smaller plant was ideally suited to laying the product on the relatively narrow pathway through the woodland track and particularly so when faced with the narrow bridge spanning the brook.
