Aston Hall's historic gardens were refurbished as part of the mansion's renovation programme. The client stipulated that all works remained in keeping with the history of the house and surrounding environment, and for this reason Fibredec was specified as the preferred surfacing option. Colas received much acclaim for restoring the gardens to their former glory.



Application Details

Aston Hall, a four hundred year old property, has undergone a multi-million pound restoration. This included the application of Fibredec to the main driveway in front of the hall and in the landscaped gardens. Colas applied a double application of Fibredec using golden gravel in March 2009, prior to the new opening of the Hall and its grounds to the public.

The finish achieved has received much favourable comment and the choice of aggregate has served to complement the natural colour of the Hall's masonry and the soft landscaping of the gardens.
