

# Delivering term maintenance contracts to the Local Authority market

## Public and Amenity Lighting Contract

### Contract Details

We undertake works ranging from small £500,000 per-year resurfacing contracts to £25m per-year PFI contracts through which we provide complete highways maintenance service.

We have recognised the importance of sustainability in our highway activities long before it became an imperative. For a number of years we have promoted in-situ road recycling techniques and cold emulsion binders to reduce the environmental impact, and safety risks, of maintaining footways and carriageways.

We are able to undertake projects the length and breadth of the country; we are currently delivering term maintenance contracts for local authorities throughout the UK.

In 2005 Colas were awarded two Street Lighting Maintenance

Contracts working for East Sussex County Council and Brighton and Hove City Council to maintain public and amenity lighting. Since then the team have successfully continued to retain the two contracts which involve the upkeep of some 72,000 lighting columns, illuminated signs and bollards, renewal of defective lighting columns and electrical components as well as the replacement of damaged lighting columns.

Within the contracts, Colas has continued to introduce innovations and technological advancements through the use of luminaries in order to reduce energy consumption and carbon emissions and the use of hand held data input devices to improve data verification and operational efficiency.

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
