Colpatch is available in 6 and 10mm grades allowing it to be used for carriageway and footway repairs as well as reinstatement patching. The material provides a permanent repair to:

- Potholes
- Utility Cuts
- Patches
- Small Road Repairs

The more varying weather conditions have resulted in a rapid growth in the sales of Colpatch and it has fast become the popular solution for pothole/reinstatement repairs.

Colpatch is manufactured at lower temperatures and does not require the use of hot boxes to maintain workability like conventional hot mix products with the benefit that less greenhouse gases are released into the atmosphere.

Colpatch has a shelf life of up to two years resulting in minimal waste; it's easy to store and even easier to handle. The material is simple to transport with delivery direct to the customer therefore removing time lost collecting material from coating plants.

Colpatch is a cold applied material that is safe, easy and quick to use. The special additive results in flexibility within the repair reducing the risk of reflective cracking. It also provides the long storage properties of Colpatch which enables the material to be stockpiled externally all year round without deterioration and remain workable in cold weather conditions. To accommodate the customers' storage capability as well as their specific uses, the material is available in a variety of options: bulk open loads; 1 tonne bulk bags; 25kg sealed bags; and where emergency repairs are required we offer 20kg air tight buckets.


